Comparing Math Topics

Students have at least one hour of math every day. What they are working on varies greatly.

For example, in grade 1, students are working on number concepts. This might include counting to 100, quickly recognizing amounts (like on dice), and of course printing numbers neatly.

Compare that to grade 8 math, where students are learning about perfect squares and square roots. Questions might be, "What are the perfect squares on either side of 32? What is the square root of 32?"
