



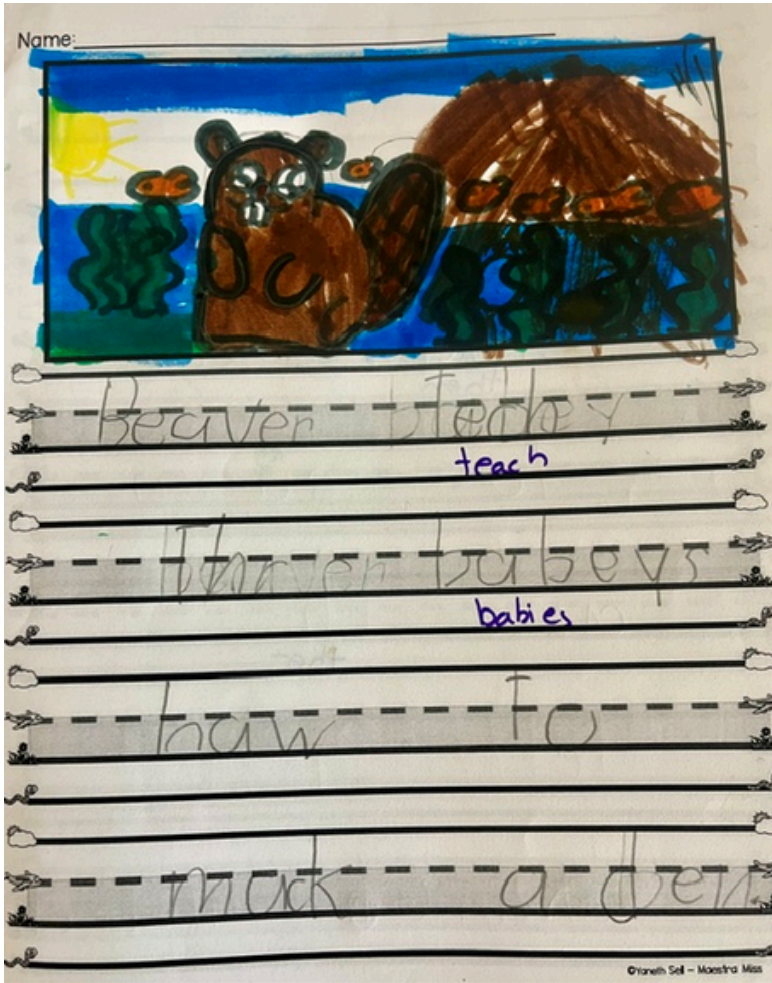
WOODLANDS SCHOOL

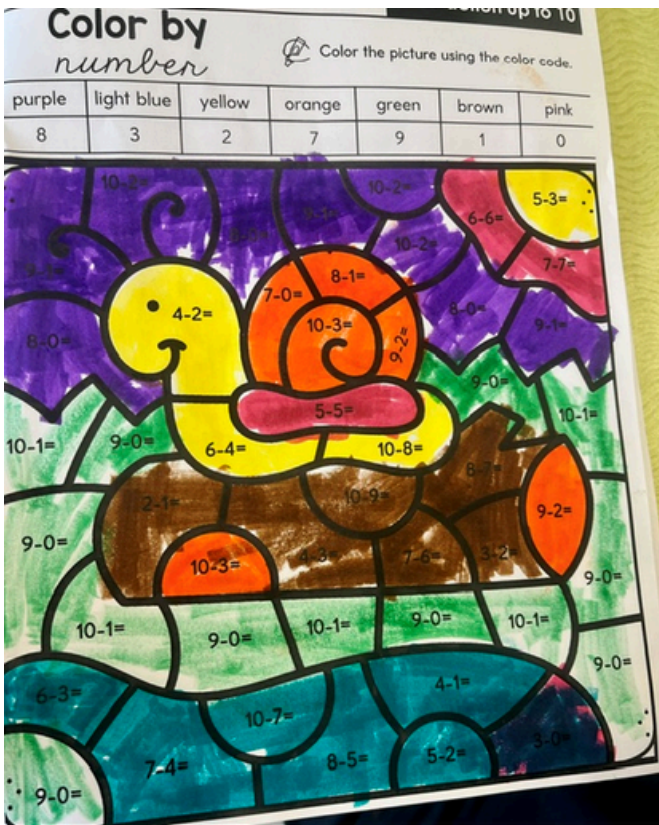
TEACHING AND LEARNING THAT IS ACCESSIBLE, EQUITABLE AND RESPONSIVE
